From **July 2 to July 27, 2025**, Geneva – as a host city of the **UEFA Women's Euro 2025** – will welcome an incredible open-air football festival at the **Fan Zone Geneva**, located on **Quai Gustave-Ador**, next to **Baby-Plage**. This space will be the vibrant heart of the festivities for all football fans.

FAN ZONE ACCESS

We encourage visitors and media representatives to use Geneva's public transportation network to easily access the **Geneva Fan Zone**, ideally located by the lakeside:

From Cornavin train station:

Bus: 20 minutes to the nearest stop.

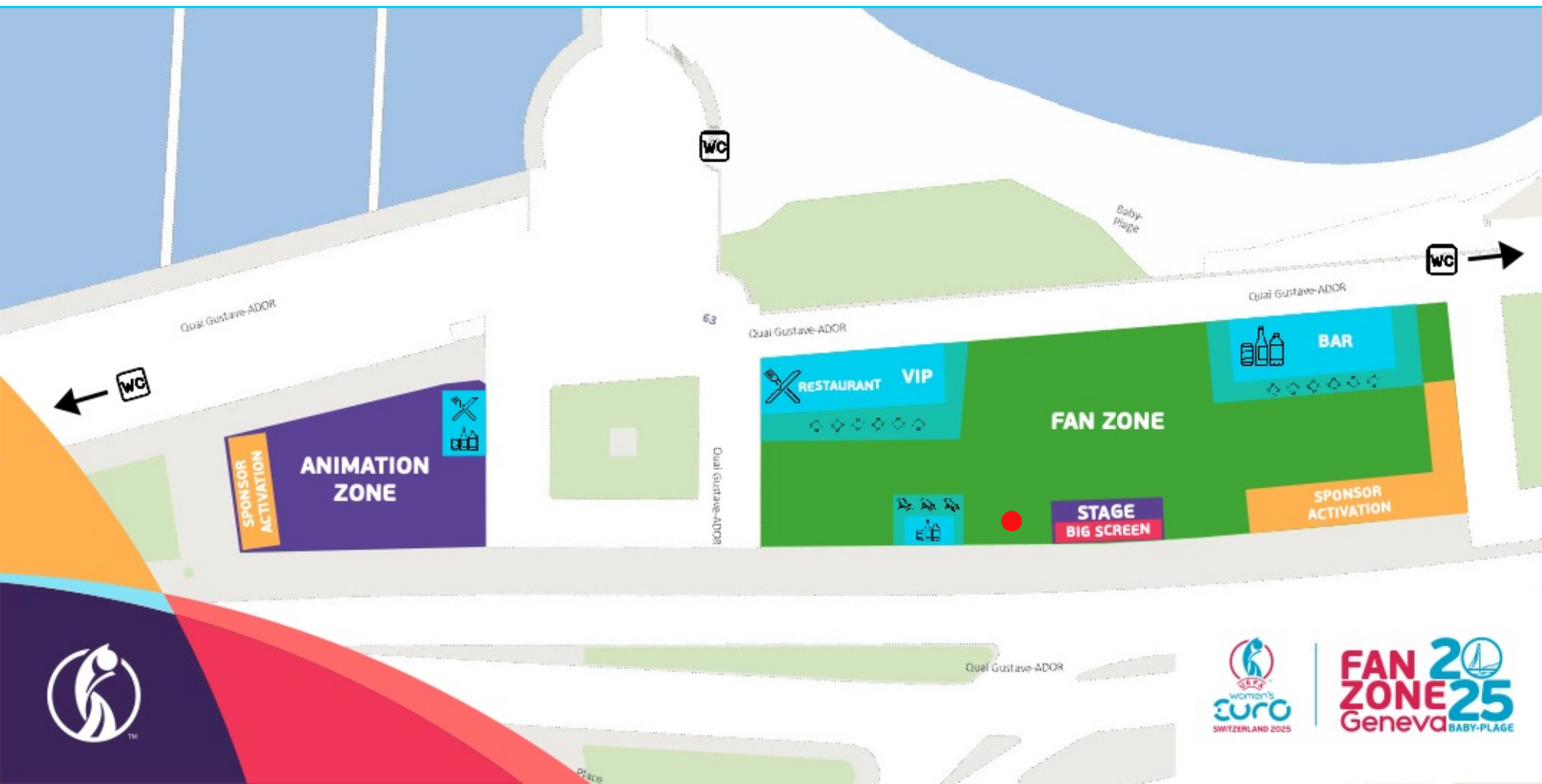
Walking: 25 minutes.

Parking: While there is no on-site parking available, **Genève-Plage** parking is located just a 4-minute walk from the Fanzone. However, we strongly recommend using public transport, cycling, or walking to reach the venue.

FAN ZONE CONCEPT

Our Fan Zone is open to all. A variety of food stalls and bars will be available on-site.

Sports activities, sponsor activations, and DJ sets will take place before each match. Set in an ideal location, the Fan Zone offers direct access to Genève-Plage and Lake Geneva. It will be open every day, including on days with no scheduled matches.

PLEASE NOTES

FILMING INSIDE THE GENEVA FAN ZONE

The image rights of performing artists must be respected at all times. Photos or recordings of shows, performances, or activities are generally **prohibited without prior consent** from the artists and/or the **City of Geneva**.

Filming within the Geneva Fan Zone is generally permitted. However, all filming activities must be organized in a way that does not hinder or endanger the flow of visitors.

Cables, tripods, and any technical equipment must be **secured according to safety regulations** and must not obstruct or pose a risk to the public.

All damage caused during filming is the full responsibility of the filming crew or organization.
